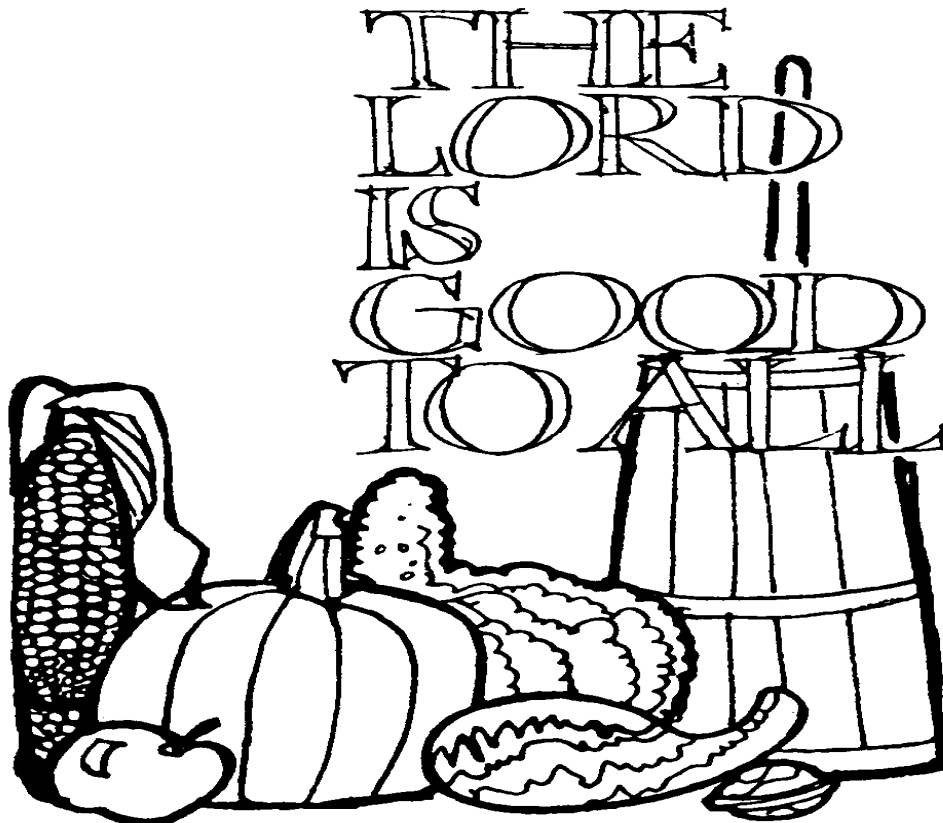


**Rest in Peace**
