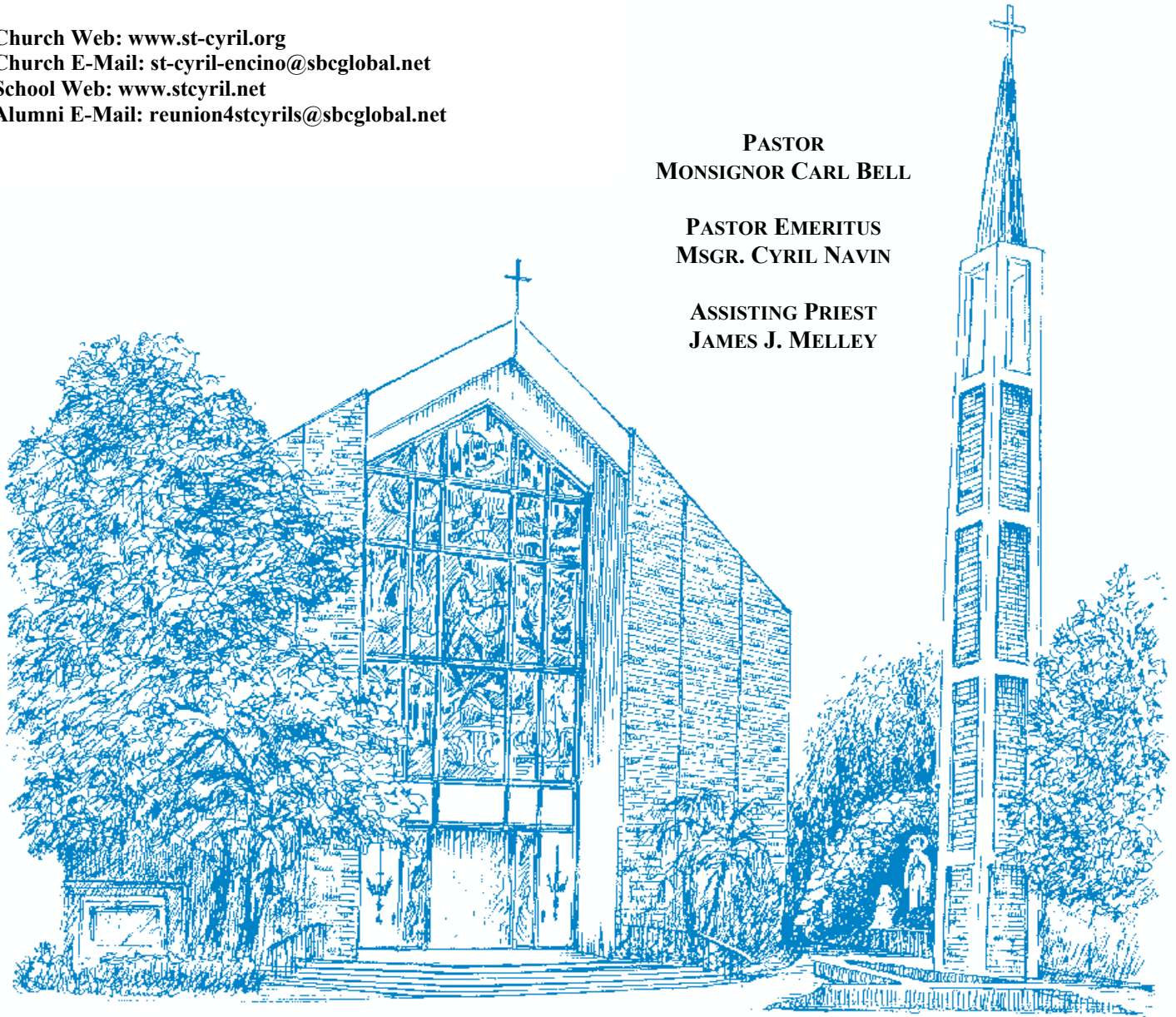

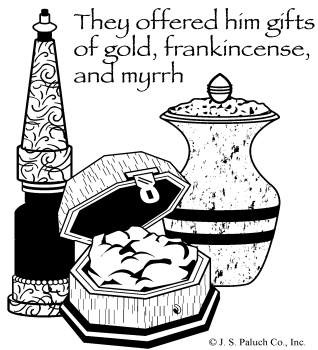

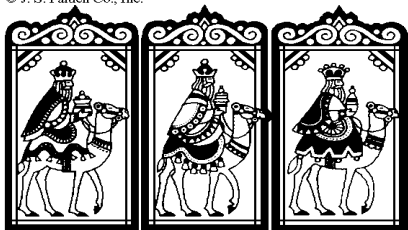

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

The RCIA is a process for welcoming adult newcomers (inquirers) into the Roman Church. The main purpose of the Rite is to assist prospective Catholics in their journey to become active members of the church community. It's a good idea to keep an up-to-date photo of your child.

A good photo could save a child's life. One of the most important tools for law enforcement in the case of a missing child is an up-to-date photograph. It's a good idea to have a good quality photo of your child available, one taken within a six months period. The photograph should be a *recent* head-and-shoulders color photo of the child with a distinct, clear shot of the child's face. It should be of school-portrait quality with a plain or solid background that does not distract from the subject. When possible, the photograph should be in digitized form and available on a compact disk (CD) as opposed to a single hard copy. This minimizes the time necessary to scan, resize and make color corrections before disseminating it to law enforcement. The photo should have space for an accurate, detailed narrative description useful to identify the child (i.e., name, nickname, height, weight, sex, age, eye/hair color, identifying marks, glasses, braces, etc.).
