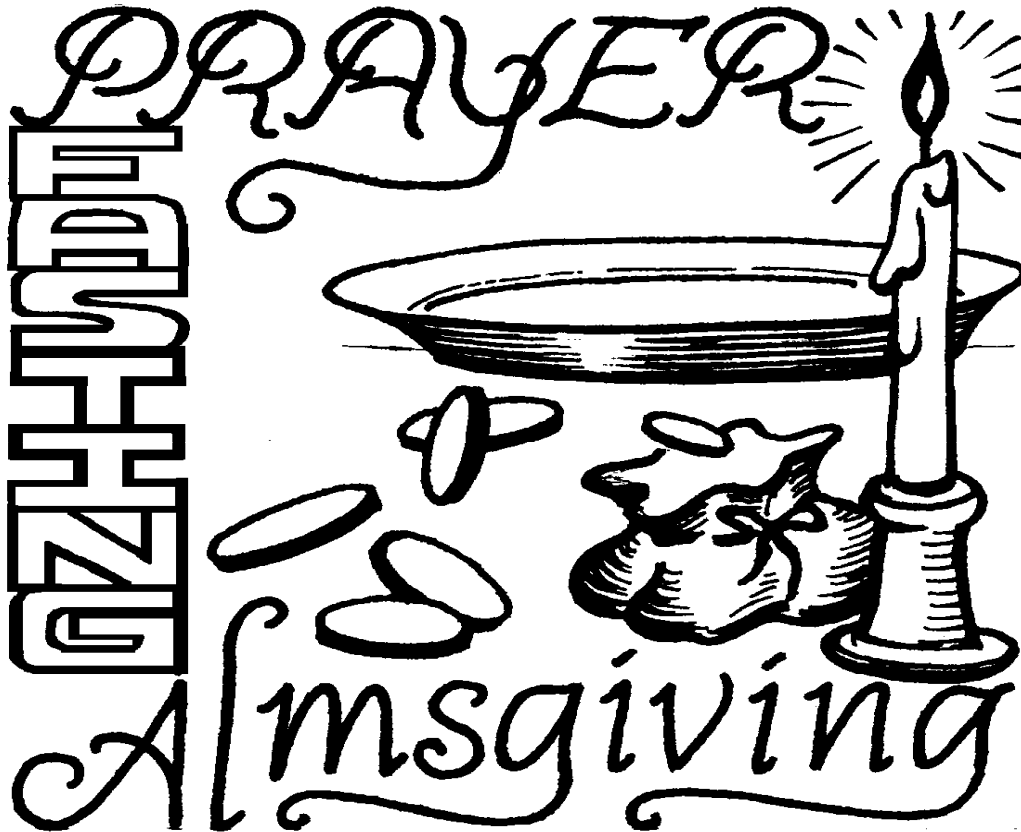

Lenten Penance

Days of abstinence - This refers to abstinence from meat and binds all who are age 14 years and older.

Days of fast - On these days we limit ourselves to **one full meal**. We may take **two partial meals**. This obligation binds all between the ages of 18 to 59 years.

What is the obligation? Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. All the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.

How serious is the obligation? The obligation to penance is a serious one. In particular, we have a grave obligation to fast and abstain on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. There is also a serious obligation to abstain on the Fridays of Lent. To excuse oneself entirely from responsibility would require a serious reason. However, to excuse oneself on a particular Friday, a proportionate reason would suffice (i.e., a special celebration, anniversary, etc.)

by the Stations of the Cross

Daily Rosary - Following the 7:30 a.m. Mass

Ash Wednesday
 Prayer, fasting, and almsgiving: these three pillars of discipline, prescribed by Jesus himself in the Sermon on the Mount, along with strict instructions not to flaunt them in public to win recognition and praise (Matthew 6:1-18), have been embraced by all the saints at the beginning of every Lent for almost two thousand years. But mention Lent and many react with a grimace or slight shudder—even now, years after official obligations have been reduced to a minimum! No wonder the Eastern Rite's "Lenten Announcement" sounds surprising: "Let us receive with joy, O faithful people, the divinely inspired announcement of Lent! The Lenten Spring shines forth! Begin the fast with joy! Let us fast from passions as well as food, taking pleasure in the good works of the Spirit and accomplishing them in love!" Saint John Chrysostom, whose feast is September 13, elaborates: "Do you fast? Give proof by your works. If you see a poor person, take pity. If you have an enemy, be reconciled. If a friend is gaining honor, don't be jealous." Keep a positive approach in all things! May the saints help us keep such a Lent!
