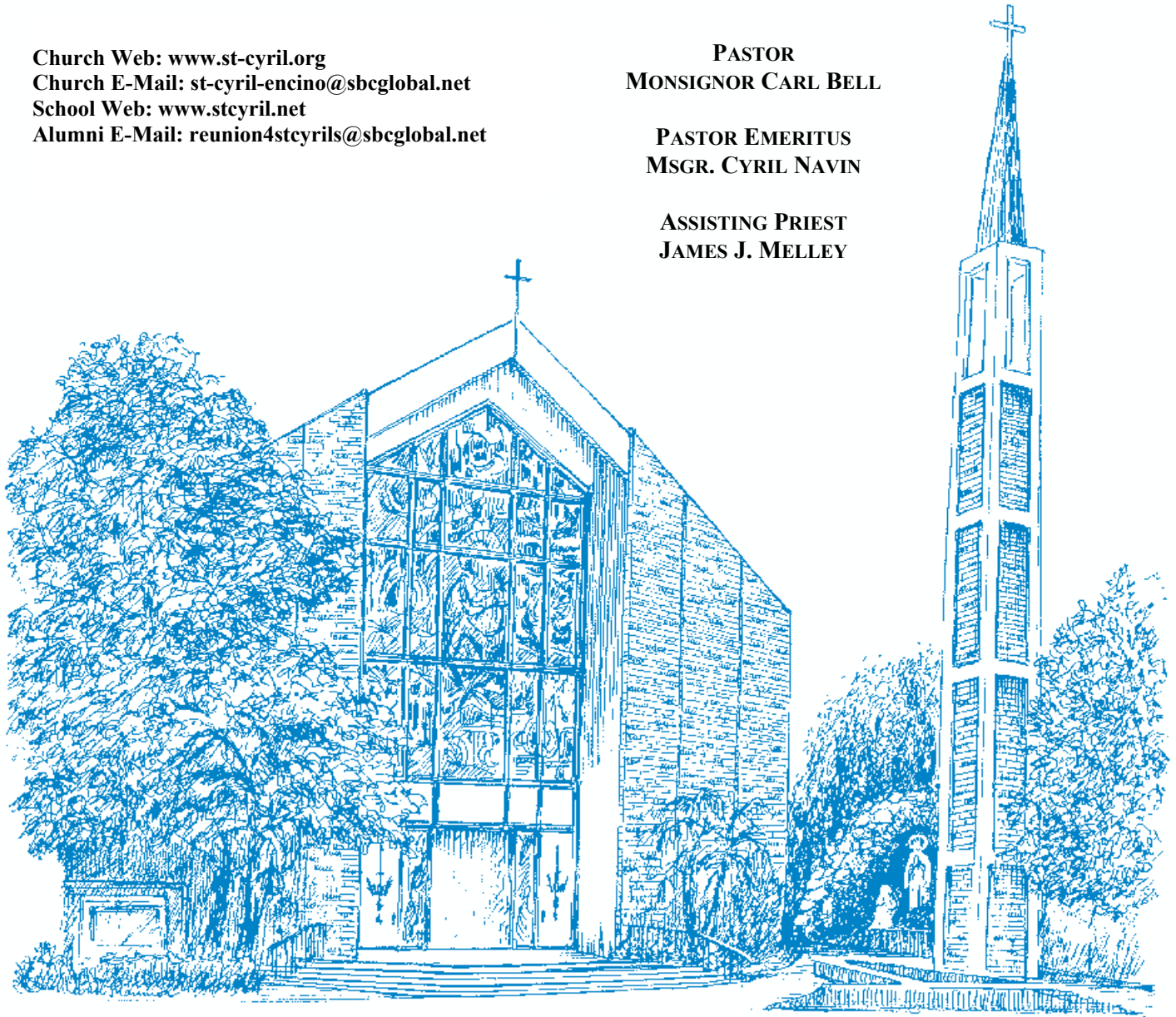

Iowa Test Scores: Parents of St. Cyril School students were pleased to learn the good news about the student Iowa Test Scores this week. Iowa Test Scores for average grade equivalencies for each of our classes in reading comprehension and total math showed marked improvement during the time spent at St. Cyril's School. Scores indicated that the longer the students spend at our parish school the more their scores increased through the years. The score refers to national grade equivalencies. For example, in 3rd grade the average student scored 4th grade in the 8th month (4.8) in reading comprehension (RC) and 3rd grade in the 8th month (3.8) in Math Total (MT). Total full school grade equivalencies: **Grade 2 RC (3.0) & MT (2.2); Grade 3 RC (4.8) & MT (3.8); Grade 4 RC (5.6) & MT (5.4); Grade 5 RC (6.7) & MT (6.3); Grade 6 RC (9.1) & MT (7.3); Grade 7 RC (9.4) & MT (8.4) and Grade 8 RC (12.4) & MT (11.4).**
