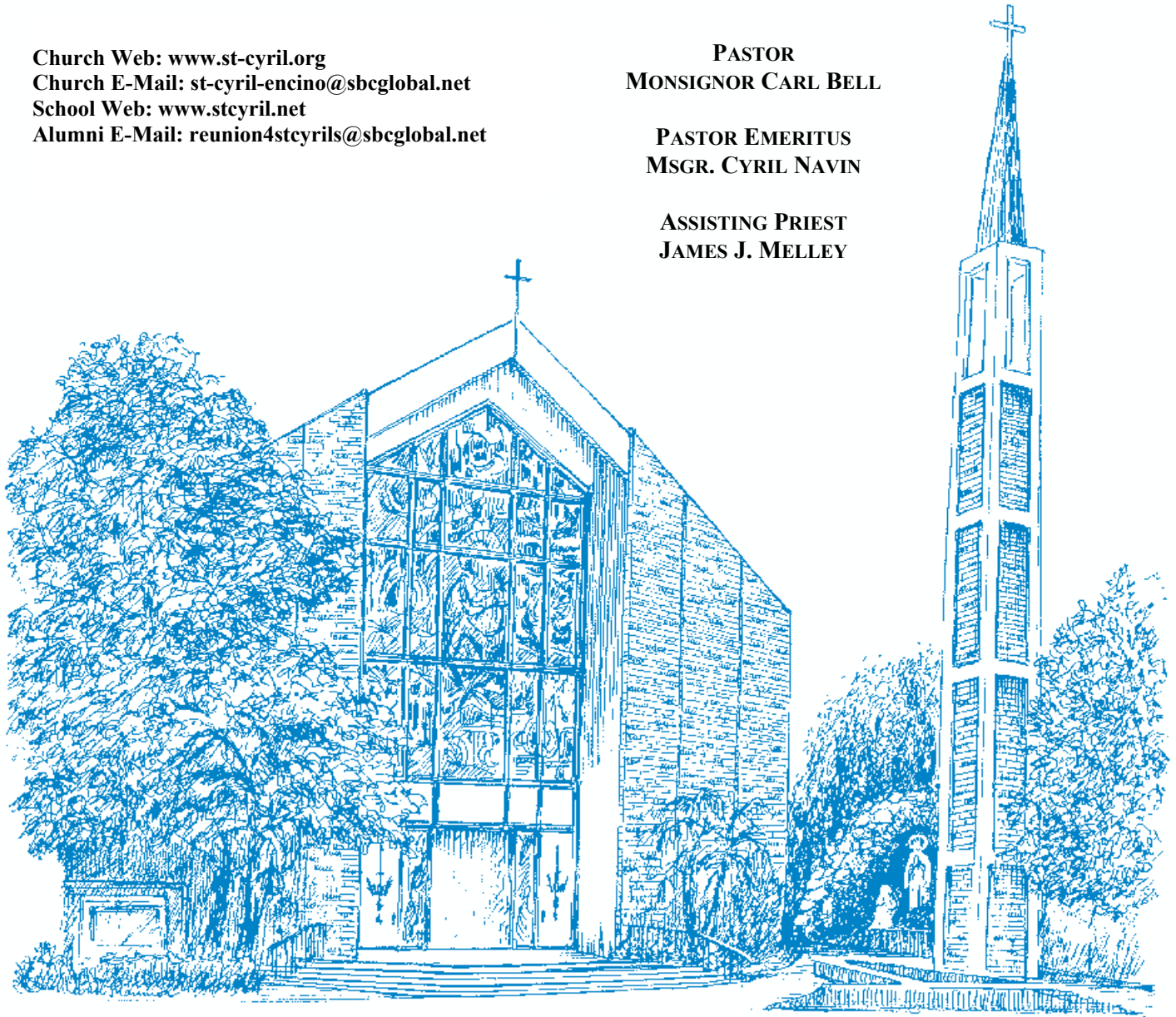

**Catholic Teaching on "Free Will"**

At issue here "Free Will" is a statement that Speaker Pelosi made in Newsweek magazine, December 21, 2009. Asked about her dissent from the teaching of the Catholic Church on such issues as abortion, Pelosi said: "I practically mourn this difference of opinion because I feel what I was raised to believe is consistent with what I profess, and that we are all endowed with a free will and a responsibility to answer for our actions. And that women should have the opportunity to exercise their free will." Speaker Pelosi is right that we are all endowed by God with free will, but what she failed to say was that this free will does not imply that all moral choices are legitimate as long as we are acting freely.

Responding to her statement, Archbishop George Niederauer of San Francisco, in whose diocese Pelosi resides, said that "it is incompatible with Catholic teaching to conclude that our freedom of will justifies choices that are radically contrary to the Gospel such as racism, infidelity, abortion, theft. Freedom of will is the capacity to act with moral responsibility; it is not the ability to determine arbitrarily what constitutes moral right." He said that abortion, "which constitutes the taking of innocent human life,...cannot be justified by any Catholic notion of freedom."

The archbishop was echoing the United States Catholic Catechism for Adults, which said the following about free will: "Human freedom is more than a capacity to choose between this and that. It is the God-given power to become who He created us to be and to share eternal union with Him. This happens when we consistently choose ways that are in harmony with God's plan. Christian morality and God's laws are not arbitrary, but are specifically given to us for our happiness. God gave us intelligence and the capacity to act freely. Ultimately, human freedom lies in our free decision to say "yes" to God.

"The best way to grow in freedom is to perform good acts. Good deeds help to make us free and develop good habits. The road to loss of freedom is through evil acts. Sin makes us slaves of evil and reduces our capacity to be free. Freedom comes from being moral. Slavery to sin arises from being immoral."
