Who are the perpetrators? According to data provided by the LA City Attorney's Office, parents constitute 84% of the child abuse perpetrators, while caregivers, relatives, foster parents and babysitters constitute the rest. Sixty percent of the perpetrators are female with a median age of 31 years and forty percent are males with a median age of 34 years.
