When we hear "Come, Holy Spirit" we think of today's story from Acts. But the truth is that today's scene is but one moment from the Spirit's long presence in salvation. The spirit of God (ruach) is present at the dawn of creation, blowing over the chaotic waters as God commands light to be. That same spirit of God filled the prophets of Israel. We also hear John's account of the Spirit as the very breath of the risen Christ on his disciples.

That same Spirit of all these biblical accounts was there at our baptism and continues to live in us. We are temples of that Spirit and witnesses to the Spirit's grace. Today's Readings

First Reading — Filled with the Holy Spirit, the apostles begin to speak in tongues (**Acts 2:1-11**).

Psalm — Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth (**Psalm 104**).

Second Reading — In one Spirit we are baptized into one body and given to drink of one Spirit (**1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13**) or **Romans 8:8-17**.

Gospel — Jesus Christ appears to the disciples and sends them on their mission with the power to forgive or retain sins through the Holy Spirit (**John 20:19-23**) or **John 14:15-16, 23b-26**.



Gifts of the Holy Spirit

There are TWO kinds of gifts of the Holy Spirit. The first gifts are intended for the *sanctification* of the person receiving them. These are *permanent supernatural qualities* enabling the graced person to be especially in tune with the workings of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety and fear of the Lord.

The second gifts of the Holy Spirit are called *charisms*. These are *extraordinary favors* granted principally for the help of others: speaking with wisdom, speaking with knowledge, faith, healing, miracles, prophecy, discerning of spirits, tongues and interpreting speeches.

In 1 Corinthians 12:6-11 nine charisms are mentioned. Other passages in St. Paul (such as 1 Corinthians 12:28-31 and Romans 12: 6-8) mention other charisms.
